DISCUSSION:

Anita Marvin:

I'm here to remind you that we would appreciate it if the park could be mowed up before this weekend. People will be getting the decorations set up.

Christmas Decorations:

Chaney- We received a phone call from the superintendent from the street department in Paris. They have offered their services with their bucket truck, it's been approved by their council. Mayor Owen- So we won't need a lift? Bohle- No we shouldn't. I'll cancel it tomorrow. Chaney- Matt has been working on the pole lights over here, trying to get those finished up this week. We've had some people from the community club reach out saying they are willing to help. The Bandstand, I'm working with a local fabricator, we are looking at an approximate 20-foot pole, with a base that is anchored to the bandstand. Then we will run lights off the pole, so well need some help getting it all set up. Other than that, I've had some people reach out about donations, I let them know we have a separate account set up and they are more than welcome to come in anytime.

Interim Loan:

Hoskin- I talked to the guy at the bank, we would have \$5000 payments that would be monthly or we can lump them up together and pay them at the end. Mayor Owen- That would be after we received our money, right? Hoskins- Yes, and when they set this all up, they knew this was going to happen. It's tied into the loan and everything from the USDA. They appropriated \$120,000 for it. Wolfe- My question is, do we pay interest on the money we draw? Chaney- Yes. I'm just trying to figure out where we will get that \$5000 a month to make the payments. We have the ERPA funds. Wolfe- I'm with you either way. We have that money we need to spend.

USIC:

Wolfe- They are going to charge me a yearly fee of \$2500, and they will charge me \$12 a locate. Anything over so many minutes they go to \$15 per quarter hr. Chaney- Anything over 30 min. Wolfe- It won't take them 30 minutes. So, each locate is \$12, after hours is \$40 and \$60 for emergency. Mayor Owen- So what is the \$2500 for? Wolfe- That is just a yearly fee to do it, then they will just charge us by the ticket. If we only have one ticket a month that is all we are going to pay. Mayor Owen- So is that to anywhere? Wolfe- It's from Horace Brocton Rd to the water tower. I want to make sure that the new line gets marked properly. It's ours now so we need to think about who's going to locate it. Haddix-Can we table that till the next meeting? Wolfe- Yeah that's fine. Mayor Owen- Next meeting.

Loan Resolution:

Mayor Owen- This is the loan resolution for the money from the USDA for the sewer plant. We have to sign it so we can move ahead and process it.

Pay Application:

Mayor Owen- Is this our final payment for Boyer? Perryman- Yes. Mayor Owen- This one is for \$144,3711.60. Is that how much we owe them. Wolfe- Yes, and all we are going to do is we approve it, she sends it to the state, and we get our money. Then she pays it.

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Change Order:

Mayor Owen- How much do we get back from that? Chaney- 90 %

Commissioner Haddix:

I have bid paper that girls drew up to sell the lot on Illinois. I'll get a sign made and put on the lot to let people to come to City Hall for information.

Commissioner Wolfe:

As you know we are down to one operator that is it. Mayor Owen- Where is Zach? Wolfe- He took a new job. Mayor Owen- Really. Wolfe- I need somebody. For tests and standby. I'll do this weekend so he is not stuck here this weekend. We need to be doing something. He will have days he has to use by the end of the year. Mayor Owen- So we need to be advertising. Wolfe- I don't know why we haven't pulled the trigger and hired somebody. Mayor Owen- Do we have any applications? Perryman- I have a pile on my desk. Mayor Owen- How many applications do we have? Perryman- Around 10. Mayor Owen- We will set a special meeting for this Thursday at 7 O'clock.

Commissioner Chaney:

We've gotten a certificate from the Secretary of State, you'd be happy to know that the city of Chrisman has 1312 inhabitants.
