We are supposed to have some guys come in to work on the sewer next week, it's going to be around \$5,000. They are supposed to work on the Clarifier, filter equipment, and train Erik. Mayor Owen- Have they sent you a list of what they are going to do with the Clarifier? I'd make them send a list.

Commissioner Chaney:

I spoke with the Insurance company about putting insurance on the new water building, and they advised to keep insurance on the old building. They said if anything were to happen to the old building, the cleanup would be more than what the building is worth.
