BUILDING PERMIT:

DISCUSSION: Chris Martinez, Scott Foster & myself are here on behalf of the Edgar County Neighborhood Watch to discuss FLOCK Camera's. They are NOT a traffic ticketing camera. They are for law enforcement detective work. The closest town near Chrisman that use them are Danville who have roughly 40 and Tilton who have 8 and 2 portables for a total of 10. What they do is mount on a regular type traffic sign pole in major routes that law enforcement and Flock suggest to have location wise. A prime example of that is we would like to put one at route 36 and route 1 two major state highways. They recommend cities put one facing the front of the vehicle and one facing the rear to take a picture of the license plate. Flock cameras go for about 2,000 to 2,500 a piece and there is an up-front cost of 500 dollars which are leased through Flock. If anything goes wrong with the camera or camera system then Flock maintains it. The purchaser doesn't own them just strictly leases them. The reason these cameras are so valuable to strictly law enforcement is let's say a stolen vehicle rolls through the intersection and Flock captures a picture of the plate. - **WW** That image gets stored in an app that is on our computers said Martinez. This is designed to be a search database to were we type in the area we are working, the make and model of vehicle we are looking for and from an investigation point of view we can find out more information on a case. As an example, Veedersburg IN. had a pickup stolen off of a pig farm and 2 hours later the person was in custody. Based off what the farmer gave to Veedersburg PD they were able to look at Danville's IL. Flock cameras found said person and arrested him in the same day. Some other examples of arrestable offenses that Flock has helped solve are Burglary, Armed Robbery, Stolen Vehicle, Domestic Battery, Someone with a Warrant, Murder, Kidnapping, Sexual Assault, and Drive Byes to name a few. Mayor Owen – So, anybody that has these camera Paris, County, across state lines can access these cameras? Martinez – Yes. Crispin – Does this take pictures all the time? **WW**- Yes Crispin – So as long as you have a time period you can go back and look? Martinez – It will separate by anything color, make, model, plate, time you name it. Foster- What we are doing with Flock is they already have maps of

Edgar County and they will have it on the map as to where they think we need to put these. However, that is not to negate your own ideas either they would be receptive of that.

Chaney – Yes, they are going to camera it tomorrow but they see tiles that need replaced and they have those tiles on site. So, this is what this is actually for so that the water will actually flow.
